#### Flu Precautions – Deb Cateora

- H1N1 appeared in late December, peaked week of January 13
- Vaccine contains 2 different strains that's helping in prevention
- This year's is behaving more severe, target population 20-49 working age
- H1N1 widespread throughout state (408 hospitalized in the tri-county area)
- Working age target population hit business and health care industry hard
- Period of time when one doesn't know they're a carrier (1-3 days before symptoms appear)
- Still contagious 7 days after symptoms resolve
- Vaccinated person can still have symptoms
- Spread via coughing, sneezing, touching
- Norovirus shows up around flu season
- Biggest challenge with vaccine: people think it will give them the flu
- Prevention works, younger working hardest to convince
- Prevention:
  - Seasonal vaccine
  - o Religious handwashing, always wash after touching face
  - Cough properly
  - o Frequent cleaning of doorknobs, lights
  - o Don't touch head, mouth, eyes
  - o Don't shake hands
  - Review sick policy, sick employees home promptly
  - Have annual planning process (August good time)
  - Reduce large group activities

# APD Rule Update – Cindy Susee – Reimbursement Policy Analyst

- Quality and Efficiently Incentive Program (HB2216)
- Temp Rules 411-070 effective October 7<sup>th</sup>
- Rules now permanent
- Rule 437 Quality & Efficiency Program
  - o 1500 bed reduction by December 2015
  - o 55 beds offline
  - o No official meetings, anticipate one in future
  - Annual rebasing, setting new rate for July 1, 2014
- P Tax no longer any exemptions except Vets Home
- P Tax reduced from \$20.79 to \$20.46
