Provider Relief Fund Update

New information was posted on the HHS CARES Act Provider Relief Fund website. The Department of Health and Human Services added a new post over the weekend that now includes a <u>General</u> <u>Distribution FAQ</u>, which provides more clarity on what providers need to do if they have received funds under the general distributions to Medicare providers. LeadingAge national reviewed and posted <u>this</u> <u>article</u> with the new information and updated the <u>Provider Relief Background</u>, <u>Considerations and FAQ</u> <u>document</u>.

- The new FAQ document discusses attestations, and the specific financial information providers who have received funds must provide in order to retain dollars. Interestingly, by submitting this information, these providers could be eligible to receive additional funds beyond those payments already received.
- While there is no new information on the status of distributing funds to Medicaid-only providers, it does state that just because a provider has not yet received a payment does not mean they are ineligible or won't receive a payment. "HHS is performing an ongoing assessment of how to distribute relief to these providers."

HUD Rental Guidance for Tenants of Federally Assisted Housing

HUD developed and disseminated a brochure for tenants within HUD federally assisted housing to provide them with important information about paying rent during the COVID-19 national emergency. The brochure encourages tenants to talk with their landlords right away about a possible rent reduction if the tenant has loss of income. Access the brochure <u>here</u>.
