CDC Opens NHSN COVID-19 Module for LTC Facilities

The CDC has opened the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) COVID-19 module for LTC facilities. The module is a customized system to track infections and prevention process measures in a systematic way. Now that it is open, Nursing Facilities can review the site or begin the reporting which is optional while the rule making is in process.
