#### **APD Issues Rulemaking Public Hearing Notices**

The Department of Human Services, Aging and People with Disabilities (APD) department has issued notices of public comment periods and hearings of the following proposed rule amendments.

- Adopting and amending rules to establish the nursing facility bariatric rate. This rule explains how a nursing facility qualifies to receive the bariatric rate through Medicaid and the required documentation.

- Requires facilities provide prospective residents with summary of services provided and those not provided (SB 815). The rule changes the definition of "Consumer Summary" and adds a new section listing documents facilities must provide to potential residents before move-in.

- Requires endorsed memory care communities to incorporate specific dementia training elements. (<u>HB 3359</u> (2017))
