Statewide	
Monitor & Respond	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OHSU statewide testing survey project • New testing division at Emergency Coordination Center • Unified coordination between all hospital labs • Voluntary mobile app for contact identification and containment • Data on at-risk communities, including tribes and people of color
Health Region	
Test & Treat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capability of 30 tests per week per 10,000 Oregonians • Sufficient hospital capacity and PPE for health care workers • Sufficient testing sites that are accessible to underserved communities
County Level	
Contain & Isolate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 600 contact tracers deployed by county • 15 per 100,000 people, with cultural and linguistic competence • PPE for first responders

Safe Communities: Who gets tested?

All Symptomatic	Anyone with symptoms tested within 48-72 hours
Group Living Situations	Where COVID-19 spread is suspected, test all asymptomatic employees and residents
Rapid Testing for Targeted Groups	First responders, health care workers, and congregate care settings where effective isolation isn't possible
